

BOMBER BOOSTERS MEETING MINUTES

October 4, 2011

The third Bomber Booster meeting of the 2011-12 school year was called to order by President Lori Maier at 6:32 pm. The following board members were present: John Andrew, Wes Meares (Treasurer), Bonnie Mitchell (Vice-President), Cindy Utecht (Secretary), Don Meares, Glen Zuroske, Kent Smith. Also present was Athletic Director Mike Edwards. Guests Earl Streufert (P.E teacher), and Keshia Nickle (Cheer Coach).

Minutes from the August 31, 2011 Bomber Boosters meeting were moved and approved.

Treasurer's report (Wes Meares)

- Wes provided copies of the September 2011 report for board review. The Boosters cash balance as of September 30, 2011 was \$26,505.

Athletic Director's Report (Mike)

- General News
 - Fall sports in full swing. The electrical outlet at the stadium concession is installed for the ice cream machine.

New Business

- Mike Edwards will keep fighting for the Bomber Boosters to run concessions for the first round of state 3A basketball, February 24 and 25th, which will be held at Richland High School Gym.
- WSN (webcast) would like the Boosters to sponsor their efforts of broadcasting the Bomber football games on the WEB. Motion Passed: To donate \$500 to WSN.
- Ellijah Gardaya was named the recipient of a \$500 scholarship from the Air-Force at the game against Chiawana. The money will come to the Boosters be dispersed into the fall of 2012 following his high school graduation.
- Earl Streufert would like a donation from the boosters towards equipment to support a new program (class). It will utilize light weights equipment, training bands, and TRX systems. Motion Passed: Booster support the concept but need to have final dollar amount of the items the PE department will purchase. The booster will vote on-line for the final amount to donate toward their purchase price.
- Keshia Nickle, cheer coach, just wondered how the boosters can help her team raise money. Motion passed: for the group to do 50/50 sales at October 28th football game.
- Wall of Fame: Bonnie Mitchell, Don Meares, and Glen Zuroske will form a sub-committee to work out details and criteria for nominating coaches for the Wall of Fame. Athletes will be inducted onto the Wall of Fame in December 2011.

- Membership Update (Kristine Boynton)

 - Total sales of \$3360
 - 41 at \$30 (regular membership), and 78 at \$60 (executive membership) so far sold from August.
 - 15 blankets sold and 16 seats sold
 - 50/50 sales for the last three home games total around \$640ish. October 21st home game will be run by Greg Fryling (Choir), and October 28th game will be run by Keshia Nickle (Cheer Coach). These folks will get parents of their students to help with the sales with Cindy Utecht (facilitating the sales) to raise money for their group.

 - Kim was not present to find out where they are. Motion Passed: the decals would be sold for \$2 each.
