

Meeting Minutes
September 3, 2013

Meeting called to order at 6:37pm by President Bonnie Mitchell. Meeting minutes from August 6th and August 13th were approved.

REVIEW TEASURER'S REPORT: \$12K reported in August for Boosters. A large amount of money was just spent on supplies to stock the concessions. Dollars were floated to Soccer until an error is fixed (money deposited in the wrong the account). Boosters owe Mock Trial money. Great turn out at the Booster table during the School Registration and Sports Clearance Night. A large amount of memorabilia was sold, especially the stadium chairs, and 38 memberships were sold.

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR'S REPORT: New speakers for the gym will be \$3K through Ted Brown Music. Working with the district to get the new speakers paid for. New hats (baseball style) have been ordered. Working to have the new dishwasher in the concessions stand installed prior to September 6th football game. Now that the arborvitae along the fence on Lee Blvd have been taken out, we need a plan/idea on a replacement. Really likes the idea of a "brick" fence, similar to that on Keene Road. Dr. Schulte has offered to meet with the Booster Board as a group. He wants to be proactive and help the Boosters with projects. Mike will arrange the meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

- Boosters Safe for RHS Office: Wes is purchasing the safe the week of September 3rd. The ASB will also have a safe next the Boosters. A label will be placed on each safe to make certain envelopes are placed into the correct safe.
- Concessions: There will be a cleaning party on Thursday, September 5th at the football concession stand to get ready for the season. Brent and Shurrie Weatherman, parents from the Dance Team, did a great job on cleaning the fryers at the end of the spring sport season; fryers are ready to go. Spent \$3,300 on supplies for the football and volleyball season. The volleyball jamboree concessions will be manned by Softball.
- Softball Raffle: No Update. A new fundraiser item softball would like to sell – elite style socks. The socks would be green and gold with an "R". Mike said all merchandise sales needs to be approved by him prior to being purchased.
- 50/50 Sales: The Booster Board voted on and approved 2/3 of the 50/50 split will be given to the club(s) selling tickets. As a minimum, the club(s) selling tickets will need to have 6 parents walking around. Individuals selling tickets must be 18 years and older. Individuals purchasing tickets must be 18 years and older. Students are not allowed to sell or purchase tickets. Tickets will be \$1.00 for 3. Cheer requested to sell 50/50 tickets at all the home football games; however, this was not agreed to by the Board. Cheer will sell tickets at the September 6th game; with Western Equipment Sales guaranteeing a \$600 pot for 50/50. Clubs have not been identified for the September 13th (Walla Walla) and October 4th (Kamiakin) games. Softball, Football and Cheer will sell tickets during the October 25th (Hanford) game. Brent Andrews will be the Booster Board member in charge of 50/50 sales during the September 6th game.
- Membership Sales: The Booster booth will be open during the games from 6:30pm – Halftime. Back to School Night a table will be set up in the cafeteria.
